97 97 Corrected - Kitchen -

--- The Original Violation Code was 4-204.112 (A)(B)(D) Temperature Measuring Devices --- Chest Freezer no thermometer present - In a mechanically refrigerated or hot food storage unit, the sensor of a temperature measuring device shall be located to measure the air temperature in the warmest part of a mechanically refrigerated unit and in the coolest part of a hot food storage unit. Cold or hot holding equipment used for TCS foods shall include at least one integral or permanently affixed temperature measuring device that is located to allow easy viewing of the temperature display. The device shall be designed to be easily readable.
